<b>Statement</b>	STWDSTS accepts one address for each student whom it serves. When the father and mother and/or guardian have joint custody of a student, then (017) Courtesy Transportation applies.
<b>Procedures</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Since transportation is provided to a student based on a single primary address, the student's alternate address shall be handled in accordance with (017) Courtesy Transportation pertaining to courtesy seats.</li> <li>2. Joint Custody Transportation is only considered when both addresses are within the attendance boundary of the school.</li> <li>3. If Joint Custody Transportation is not available the father and mother and/or guardian must decide which address is the primary address. Transportation will be provided from that address if it meets all eligibility criteria.</li> </ol>
<b>Joint Custody Alternating Each Week</b>	On a permanent basis, when a student resides alternately for one week with his/her father or guardian, and the next week with his/her mother or guardian, transportation services can be granted by STWDSTS, in accordance with (017) Courtesy Transportation.
<b>Joint Custody During the Same Week</b>	<p>On a permanent basis, when a student resides, during the same week, alternately with his/her father or guardian for a few days, and then with his/her mother or guardian for another few days, STWDSTS can grant transportation services if:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The student is in Grade 9 or a higher grade.</li> <li>2. The alternate pick-up and drop-off location meets the criteria governing the granting of courtesy seats (017) Courtesy Transportation.</li> </ol>
